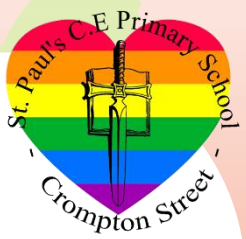


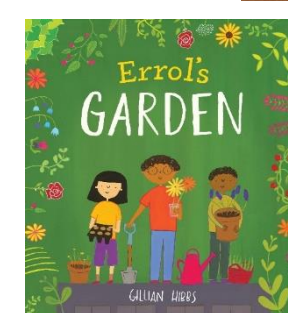
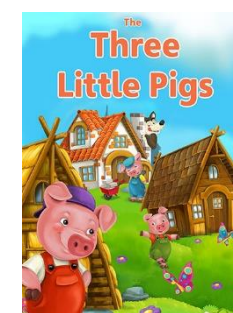
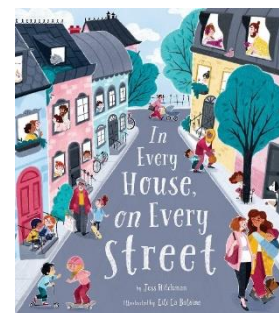
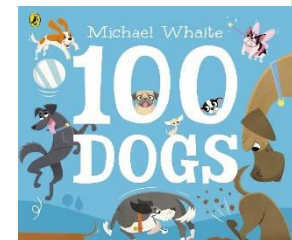
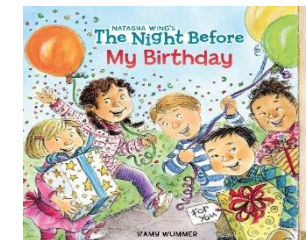
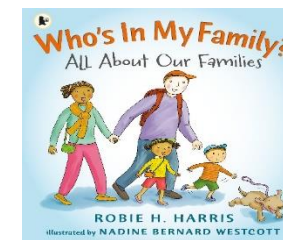
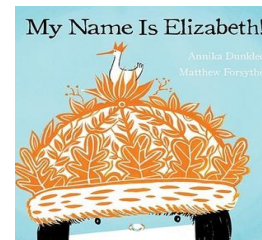
Learning Challenge: Nursery Term: Autumn 1 Who Lives in My House?

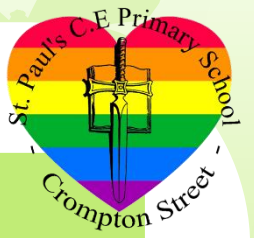


What will I know by the end of the unit?

Everybody has a name and names are special to us.	We all have a name that is special to us. We use people's names when we want to talk to them.
Families are the people who care for us and look after us.	There are many different types of families. Some families are big and some families are small, some live close together and others live far away. Children will begin to talk about their own family background and history.
Birthdays are a celebration of the day we were born.	Everyone has a birthday and we do lots of different things to celebrate. Children will begin to talk about dates, find the month of their birthday and share memories of their birthday.
Pets are living creatures that need care and love.	Animals that live at home with us are called pets. There are lots of different kinds of pets. All pets need love and special care and we must be kind and gentle when interacting with them.
Different materials are used to make different kinds of houses.	Materials have different purposes and some materials are better suited to make houses. Children will begin to describe similarities and differences between materials.
Harvest marks the start of a new season.	Harvest is the process of gathering crops in and saying thank you to God for the food that has grown. Children will use all their senses to explore Harvest.

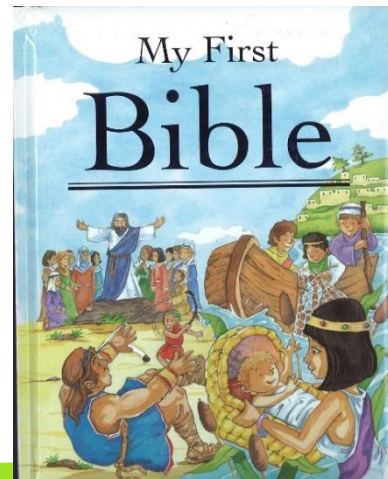

Harvest	The time of year we celebrate all the fruit and vegetables we have grown.





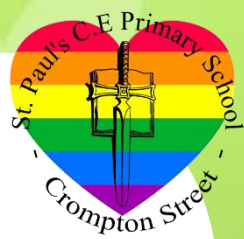
What will I know by the end of the unit?	
Everyone is unique and special.	There are differences and similarities between all people. Everyone is special in their own way.
Everyone has different families.	We have people at home who love and care for us. All families and homes look different.
Babies are welcomed into Christianity by Baptism.	Babies are welcomed into the world. Babies are baptised which welcomes them into the Christian family.
Aqiqah is how babies can be welcomed into Muslim tradition.	Aqiqah and Shahadah are different ways of welcoming a baby into the Muslim tradition. Babies receive a message at the beginning of their lives to welcome them into the world.
Hindu brothers and sisters celebrate their love at Rakshan Bandhan.	Rakshan Bandhan is a time to focus on the bond between siblings. A rakhi is exchanged between siblings at this festival.

Baptism	A Christian rite of welcoming children into the Church by sprinkling them with holy water.



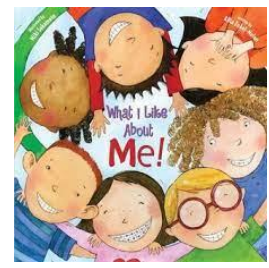
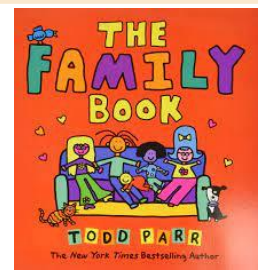
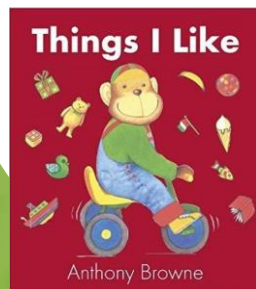

P.S.H.E. Nursery – Autumn 1: Me and My Relationships



What will I know by the end of the unit?	
Recognise that we are all unique	Children will be able to identify some things that make them special and ways they are different from other children.
Name and label parts of the body	Children will be able to name some familiar parts of their body. They will begin to understand that there are some parts of our bodies that are private that we keep covered up with clothes.
Understand that all families are different	Children will explore different types of families and that families are people who love and care for each other.
Use senses to explore the world around them	Begin to talk about the 5 senses and use simple vocabulary to describe touch, taste, smell, sound and sight.
Name and understand some common emotions	Begin to understand and label their feelings . Give suggestions for why we might feel a certain way or how their actions might make others feel.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Unique	The only one of its kind. Not like anything else.
Body	The parts of a person or animal.
Family	A group of people who love and care for each other.
Senses	How we explore the world around us: sight, smell, hearing, taste, and touch.
Emotions	The way we feel when something happens to us. E.g. sad, happy, angry, scared.
Safe	Not dangerous. When we feel safe we know we are not going to be hurt or sad.
