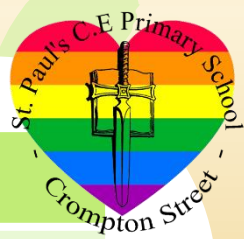


RE Nursery Spring 1 – What Makes A Good Friend?

A good **friend** is someone you like to spend time with. They help you when you need help. They play with you, share with you and listen to you.

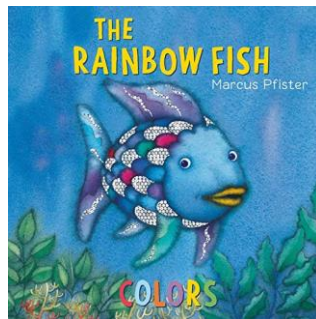
Jesus had some special friends called **disciples** who he did things with. We can be friends of Jesus' too.

Prayer Flags

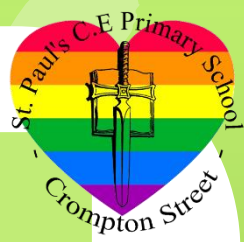

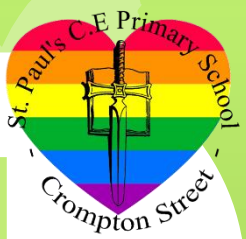

What Colours Can We See Around the World?



What will I know by the end of the unit?

Primary colours are used to make lots of other colours.	We can make purple with blue and red, orange with yellow and red and green with yellow and blue.
Chinese New Year is celebrated at a different time to our new year.	People celebrate Chinese New Year by setting off fireworks, releasing Chinese lanterns, decorating with red decorations and dressing up in red clothes.
We need to take care of our world and make sure we look after it.	We can help our Earth by always remembering to put our rubbish in the bin, turning off the lights when we leave a room, and being careful with how much water we use.
Each country around the world looks very different.	Each country has different people, buildings, and cultures. Some countries will look similar to our own and others will look very different .
Children around the world all have different lives and experiences.	Children eat lots of different types of food, some children work instead of going to school, children speak different languages.
Pictures from the past are often in black and white.	We can also use the clothes, vehicles and buildings in the pictures to help us decide if it is new or old.
