

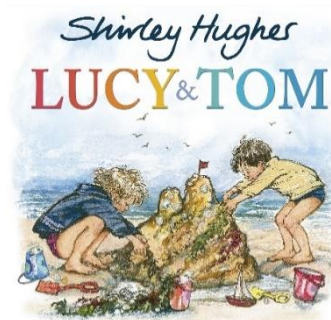
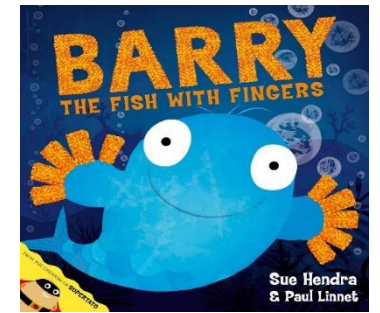
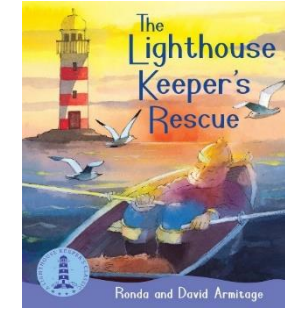
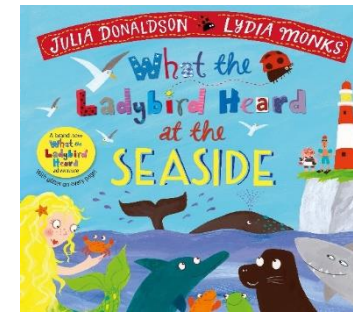
## Learning Challenge: Nursery Term: Summer 2 What Will you see at the seaside?

### What will I know by the end of the unit?

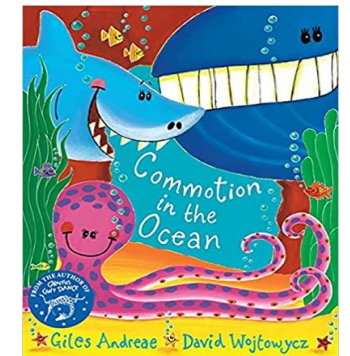
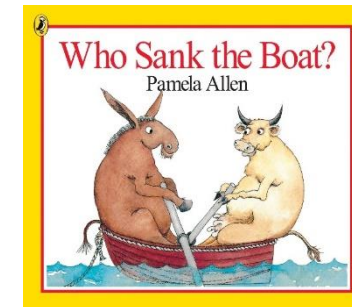
I can list things I would see at the seaside.	At the seaside I would see the sea, the sand, sandcastles, buckets, spades, people, sun.
I can explain why lighthouses are important.	Boats that are sailing in the dark need lighthouses to guide them past dangerous rocks.
I can use different materials to create a lighthouse picture.	We need to choose appropriate materials and colours to create a picture.
I can investigate what Nursery's favourite flavours of ice cream are.	When we are investigating, we only need to change one thing. For this investigation we are changing the flavour of ice cream.
I can investigate <b>floating</b> and <b>sinking</b> objects.	Objects will either float or sink in water depending on the material they are made of and how dense they are.
I can name creatures that live in the sea.	The sea is home to many creatures and plants such as sharks, fish, whales, dolphins, corals, seaweed.

### Key Vocabulary Definition

<b>Seaside</b>	A place by the sea which usually has a beach area.
<b>Beach</b>	A strip of land covered in sand at the edge of a body of water.
<b>Lighthouse</b>	A tower containing a light to guide ships at sea.

**Jewish** and **Christian** people tell the story of Noah's Ark.

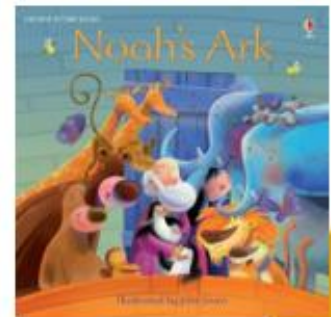
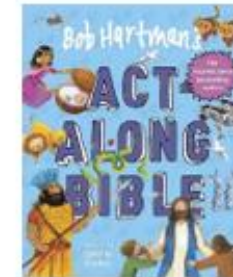
**Muslim** people tell the story of the boy who threw stones at trees.

<b>Muslim people</b>	People who believe there is one God called Allah and that Muhammad is the prophet of Allah.

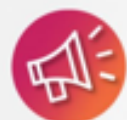

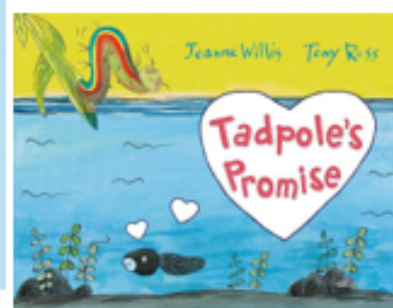
