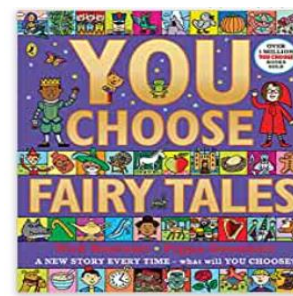
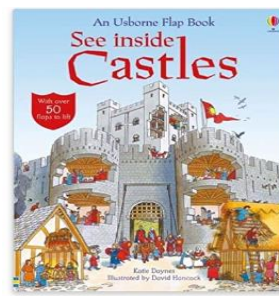
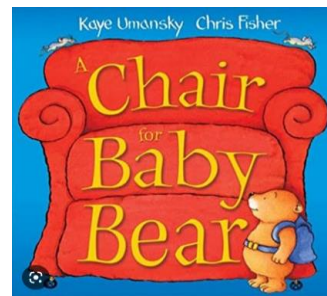
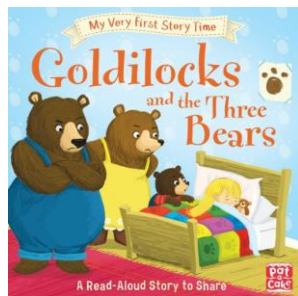
I know that things change over time.	Materials can look different e.g. different colours.

## What will I know by the end of the unit?

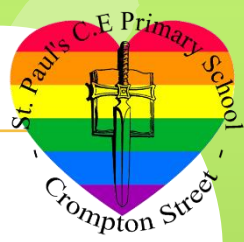
There was a time when we did not have electricity.	We can use our senses to describe different materials.

<b>Castle</b>	A castle is a large building that is often surrounded by a moat.
<b>Materials</b>	Materials are what an object is made from.
<b>Hard</b>	Cannot be crushed or cut easily.
<b>Smooth</b>	Doesn't have any holes, lumps or uneven parts.
<b>Shiny</b>	The object reflects light easily.
<b>Sticky</b>	A sticky substance is soft, or thick and liquid, and can stick to other things.
<b>Soft</b>	Can easily be crushed, cut or bent.

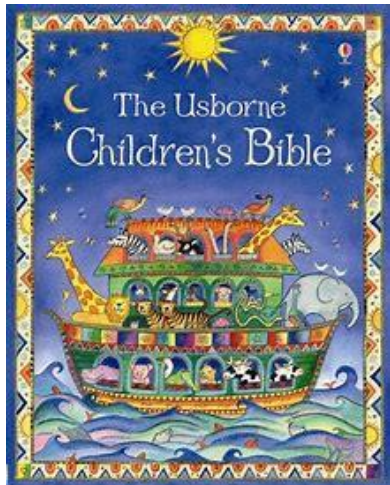
# R.E. – Reception Spring 1 -Why is the word 'God' special to Christians?
