During our maths sessions, children will begin to write and represent numbers 6 and 7. They will also continue to work on remembering our numbers 1-5.



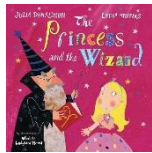
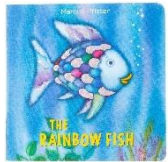
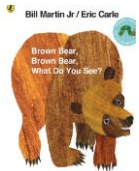
## Reading
