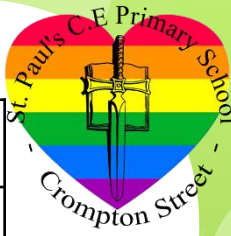


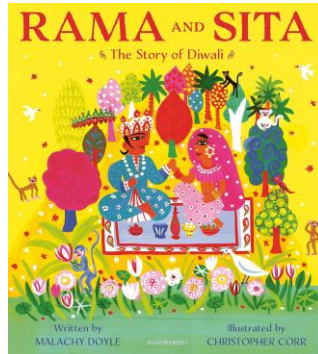
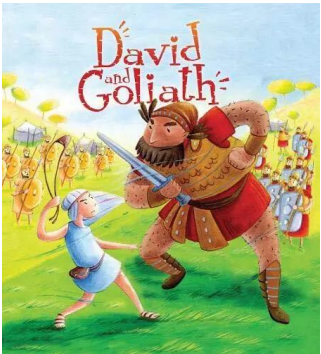
## R.E. – Reception Summer 2 -Which stories are special and why?

What will I know by the end of the unit?

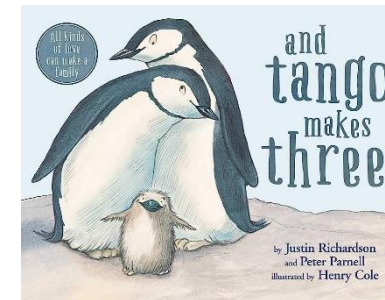
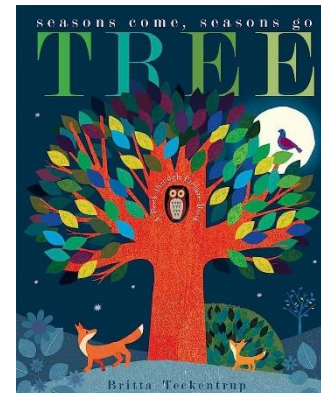
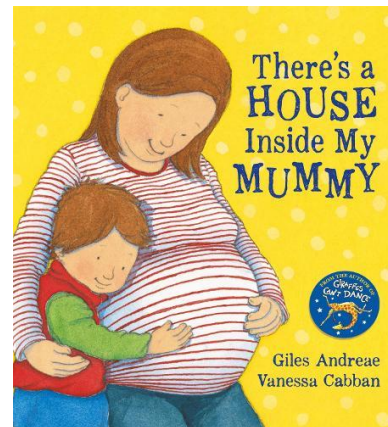

<b>traditions</b>	A common way of doing things. It is something special that many people do, and have done for a long time.
<b>culture</b>	Culture is a pattern of behavior shared by a society, or group of people. Many different things make up a society's culture. These things include <u>food</u> , <u>language</u> , <u>clothing</u> , <u>tools</u> , <u>music</u> , <u>arts</u> , customs, beliefs, and <u>religion</u> .
