## **Statutory Assessment**

The DfE have advised that the following assessments will take place in 2025. Teachers have been working hard with the children to prepare them for their assessments, please see below the time of when assessments will take place:

Year 6 - End of Key Stage 2 SATs 12 - 15 May 2025

Year 1 - Phonics Screening Check 9 – 13 June 2025

Year 4 - Multiplication Times table Check (MTC) 9 - 20 June 2025

We request that you do not take any term time holidays during these assessment periods. If at any time you wish to discuss the assessment process with your child's class teacher, please make an appointment to meet with them through the school office or Class Dojo.

#### **Playframes**

Despite the improving weather, a polite reminder that once children have been collected from class, they and their siblings are not permitted to use any of our playground climbing frames. Please do not be offended when staff ask them to stop, as it is for your child's safety.

The equipment on each playground has been designed specifically for the age range of children who play there, ensuring that it is age appropriate and safe.
