On **Palm Sunday**, Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. The people waved palm leaves and shouted 'hosanna'.


We eat hot cross buns on **Good Friday**. They have a cross on them to remind us about when Jesus died on a cross.





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
What will I know by the end of the unit?

The job of a farmer is very important.	Farmer's are very important, they help to take care of all the animals and make sure our food can grow.	


