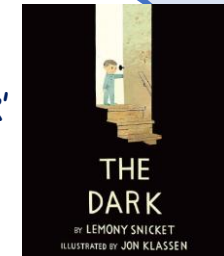
### English

In our English lessons this half term we will be doing written work from a book called 'The Dark' by Lemony Snicket. We will be writing our own versions of the story.

This half term we will still be continuing with our spellings and learning how to use inverted commas, prefixes and subordinating clauses in our grammar.

### Maths

In Maths we are continuing with addition and subtraction, where we will be learning different mental and written methods for adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers. We will also be learning our 4 and 8 times tables and investigating patterns within these.



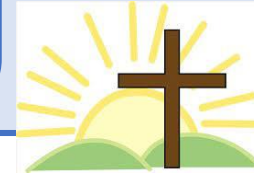
### P.E.

Year 3 will have P.E. on a Wednesday and Friday. They can wear their PE kit to school on these days: black/grey joggers, red t-shirt and black trainers. Children should wear their normal school jumper or fleece for outdoor sessions.



### R.E.

In R.E. we are focusing on the creation story and what Christians learn from this and use in their daily lives. We will also have a special lesson on Easter



### Science

This half-term our enquiry question is; 'How does this blossom become an apple?' We will be investigating plants and the function of the key parts of a flowering plant. We will also be doing an experiment to find out how a plant grows in different environments.



### Reading Books

Reading as regularly as possible to an adult can really help your child's progress. We would like to see your child read a minimum of FIVE times a week, which will be checked every Monday. Once they have read, an adult should sign and date their Reading Record.



Homework is set every Friday and should be returned by Wednesday. Please encourage your child to complete their homework to a high standard.

### Geography

In Geography Year 3 will be continuing: Why do so many people choose the Mediterranean for their holidays?

In this topic as geographers we will be investigating different countries in the Mediterranean, using map skills, looking at the human and physical features of Mediterranean countries and compare these to the UK.
