English

In English, we are going to be looking at 'Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram. We will create postcards to send to Earth! Over the half-term we will be recapping our phonics knowledge from reception and practising a range of new phonics.

Maths

In Maths, we are continuing to focus on addition and subtraction and the meaning of their symbols (+ - =). We will be beginning to present and interpret data in block diagrams, in addition to understanding the months and days in a year.

P.E.

Year 1 will have P.E. on a Thursday and Tuesday afternoon. Your child's kit should consist of black shorts, black pumps, and a St. Paul's red t-shirt. For outdoor sessions; long black joggers, trainers and a sweatshirt can be worn.



R.E.

Who do Christians say made the world and Easter?
In R.E. we will be learning about Easter and celebrating new life.

Science

This half-term, we will be learning focusing on physics and why it goes dark in the winter. We will be looking at the seasonal changes to help us with this.

Reading Books

History

Year 1 will be learning about The Great Fire of London, and how it changed London. We will look at the causes and consequences of the fire using different sources and evidence, and compare these sources.
