


## <u>Year 1 Newsletter</u> <u>Spring 1</u>

### English

In English, we are going to be looking at The Owl Who Was afraid of the Dark. Over the halfterm we will be recapping our phonics knowledge from reception and practising a range of new phonics.

### <u>Maths</u>

Our Maths focus for Spring 1 are making comparisons between different numbers (10 more and 10 less). We will then begin to look at odd and even numbers, and how you can group these numbers into pairs. We will also begin to understand and recognise mathematical equations (+ - =). P.E.

Year 1 will have P.E. on a Tuesday and Wednesday. They can wear their PE kit to school on these days: black/grey joggers, red t-shirt and black trainers. Children should wear their normal school jumper or fleece for outdoor sessions.

# Crompton Street R.E.

In R.E. we will be learning about God and creation. This involves understanding that Christians believe we should take care of our world. We will also be looking at Hindu gods (Brahma and Vishnu) as part of the Hindu creation story.

### **Science**

This half-term, we will be learning about What materials could you use to make Callum's new house? This involves our Chemistry skills, experimenting with everyday materials.

### **Reading Books**
