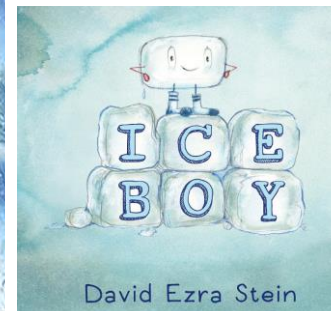
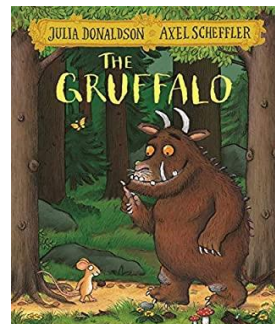
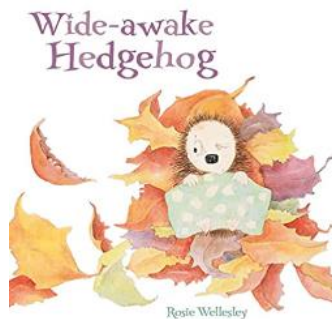
What do I need to know from previous topics? (Nursery)

Autumn



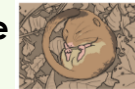
The season before winter when the leaves begin to fall off the trees.

A good friend is loyal and kind.	I am polite to others.

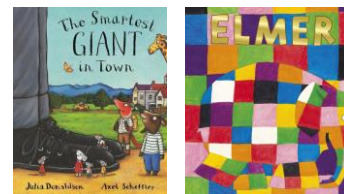
