During our maths' sessions, children will begin to write and represent numbers 8, 9 and 10. We will also begin to look at different 2D shapes.

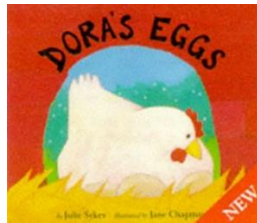
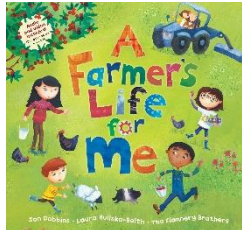


## Reading
