English

In English, we are going to be looking at 'Bog Baby', focusing on capital letter, full stops, and including 'and' and 'because' into our sentences. We will continue our Phonics over this last half term, ready for Year 2.



Maths

In Maths, we will begin to look at time, focusing on o'clock and half past.

P.E.
