


R.E. – Reception Spring 1 -God/Creation: Why is the word 'God' so important to Christians?




What will I know by the end of the unit?






I know that things change over time.	Materials can look different e.g. different colours.

Castle	A castle is a large building that is often surrounded by a moat.
Materials	Materials are what an object is made from.
Hard	Cannot be crushed or cut easily.
Smooth	Doesn't have any holes, lumps or uneven parts.
Shiny	The object reflects light easily.
Sticky	A sticky substance is soft, or thick and liquid, and can stick to other things.
Soft	Can easily be crushed, cut or bent.
