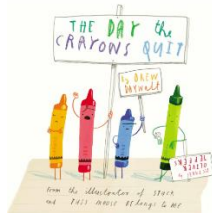
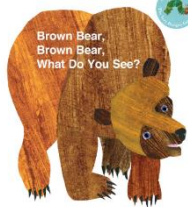
## Reading

In R.E., we will be exploring why the word 'God' is special for Christians. We will be reading the Creation story and exploring how we can take care of our world.

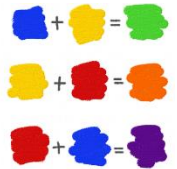


## P.E
