

Photography and Videoing of school related events

As always at St Paul's we value the support of parents and appreciate that during special events, such as Christmas plays and class assemblies, parents like to take photos or videos of their children as a lasting memory to keep and share in the future.

We are happy to continue to allow parents to undertake photography and videoing in school, however in order to safeguard and respect the wishes of all parents and children we ask that you follow the school policy below:

Parents are permitted to photograph and video our school events, such as the Christmas play and class assemblies providing that the following guidelines are adhered to:

- **Parents must not publish photos online, including on any social media sites. Any such images published online may contravene Data Protection legislation.**
- **Photos may only be taken at the location of the event (for example, the school hall)**
- **Photos should not be taken in classrooms, or elsewhere unless authorised by the Headteacher.**
- **Cameras or devices incorporating a camera should not be used on school premises at any time outside designated events, unless authorised by the Headteacher.**

Failure to adhere to these conditions may lead to a withdrawal of permission to use any type of recording equipment at future events.

In the event of continuing to record at events following a withdrawal of permission, consideration will be taken to withdraw the right to attend future events.
