English

In our English lessons this half term we will be linking our literacy work with our history topic of 'Ancient Greece'. We will be reading some Greek Myths and writing character descriptions about a hero and a monster! As well as writing a recount from the first Olympic games!

We will also continue to work on our Y3 grammar and spelling.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths in summer 1 we are focusing on Multiplication and division and learning different mental and written methods to complete fluency and reasoning and problem solving questions. We will also be starting to look at fractions and decimals.
