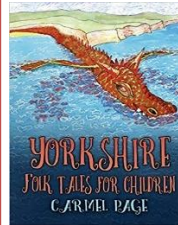

- Locate hills, mountains, coasts and rivers in the UK on a map **(3,4)**
- Study photos, pictures and maps to ask questions and make comparisons between locations **(5)**
- Identify land use patterns in the UK **(5)**
- Understand how the key features and land use in the UK has changed over time, e.g. population, immigration **(7)**
