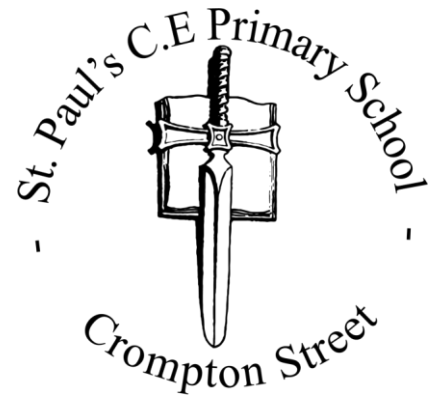


# St. Paul's CE Primary School Headteacher's Newsletter Spring Term 2022
