School Closing

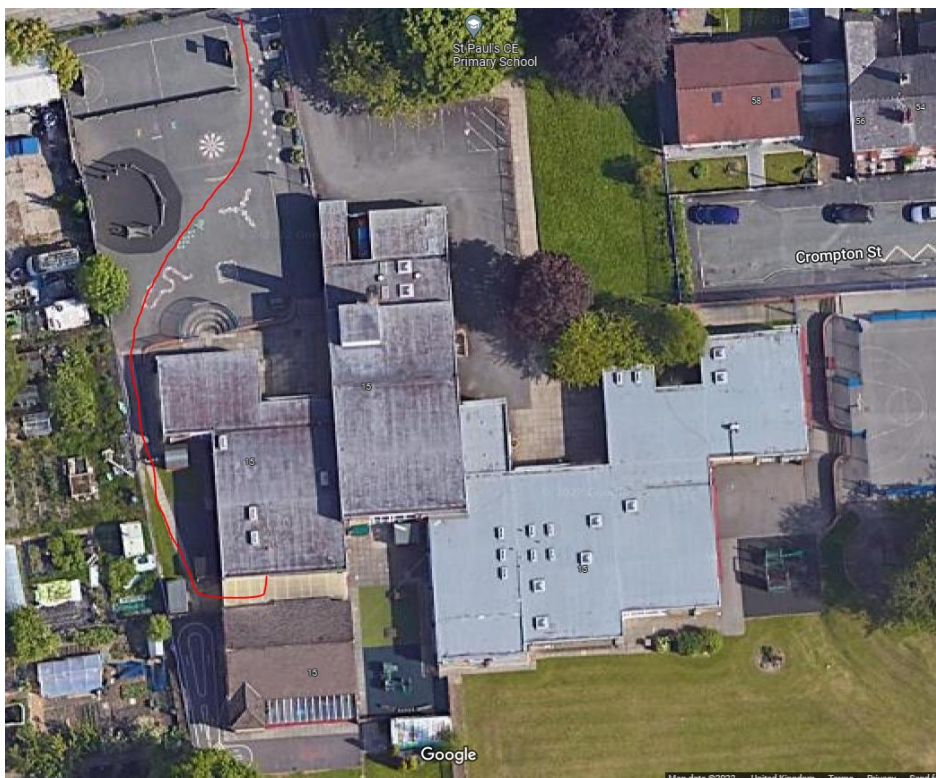
School will finish for all children at the normal time on Thursday 28th July 2022.
