




## Reception Newsletter Summer Term 2021




### P.E. - Friday

This half-term, we will develop our throwing and catching skills through a wide range of different sports. Children will begin to play competitively, when applying their skills.

### English

This term, we will be reading a range of texts that introduce a range of different professions, as we learn all about the people that help us!

Using these texts, all children will continue to develop and apply their phonics' knowledge to read and write simple sentences.



### Maths

Within our maths sessions, we will begin to look at numbers bigger than 10. Children will learn to apply their understanding of numbers to 10 to begin to understand the place value of teen numbers.



### Our Beautiful World!!!

Through our topic, children will explore a wide range of texts and activities to learn all about the world in which we live.

Reception will engage in craft making, gain an understanding of how the world has changed over time, as well as using a map to appreciate our own school grounds.

### Reading Books



Reading as regularly as possible to an adult can really help your child to progress and develop their key skills and of becoming an early reader.

This half term, children will be continuing to develop their knowledge of phase 3 sounds. These will start to feature in your child's reading book.



Children will be introduced to phase 4 sounds. Phase 4 sounds are consonant blends.

We would like to see your child read a minimum of FIVE times a week. Once they have read to an adult, the adult should sign their Reading Records.

Please continue to practice the Reception tricky words from your pack.

This half-term's tricky words are: their, called, Mr, looked, asked and could.
