






Nursery Newsletter Summer Term 2022


English

This half-term, we will be reading a range of stories relating to our "What will we find at the seaside?" topic, completing a variety of mark making activities based on these stories, applying our phonics knowledge by writing the sounds we can hear and beginning to write CVC words.



Maths

Within our maths sessions, we will be revisiting some of the things we have already learnt, including consolidating our knowledge of numbers 1-10, comparing numbers using 'more' and 'fewer', and exploring and creating patterns.
